



Maternal Telehealth Program

Orlando Health Bayfront Hospital Center for Women and Babies is offering a free program designed to provide telehealth services throughout pregnancy and up to one year after delivery.

All qualifying pregnant and postpartum birthing persons with an eligible diagnosis and/or social determinant of health are enrolled to be followed up to a year post delivery. These efforts support the mission of decreasing the pregnancy and postpartum complications in Pinellas County while improving the health and quality of life for the mothers and babies served in our community.

What Do We Do?

We offer telehealth services at no cost.

What Is Telehealth?

Telehealth lets you meet your care team from a phone, computer or tablet – without having to go to the clinic.

Who Is the Program for?

Pregnant or postpartum individuals who live in Pinellas County.

When Do We Meet?

We meet at your convenience.
